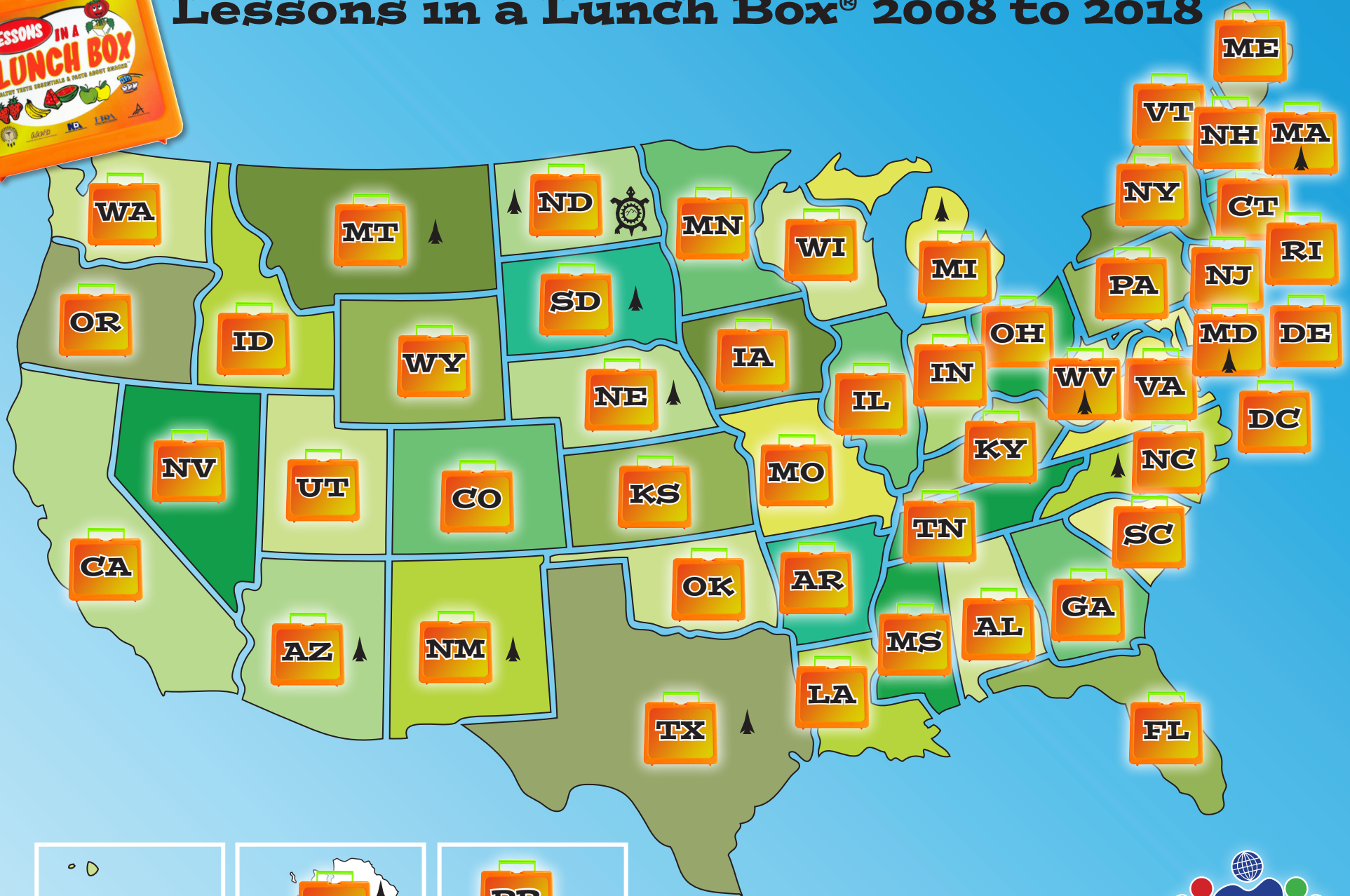

Lessons in a Lunch Box — 2018 to Date

- ✓ Lessons in a Lunch Box sustainability beyond 10 years to be accessed by The Children's Oral Health Institute.
- ✓ Funds raised in 2017 afforded 10,000 lunch boxes for the 2018 winter program cycle, January through March.
- ✓ 80 elementary schools received program presentations between January 10th and March 30th.
- ✓ Every elementary school on Turtle Mountain Reservation, North Dakota has received the program presentation.
- ✓ The entire Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania elementary school district received program presentations, February 1st.
- ✓ Braille lunch boxes made available with application of the legends by Maryland School for the Blind.
- ✓ Sign language video utilized, produced with funding provided by the Benco Dental Supply Company.

Since 2008, 55,000 lunch boxes have reached children and families in 50 states, DC and Puerto Rico via support from 52 dental schools, their student dentists and faculty, volunteers from community, corporate and organized dentistry, civic organizations and many others.

Chronology of Highlights 2006 – 2017

- April 4, 2017** LIALB program reaches 4 schools for deaf children and 1 for the blind.
- November 11, 2017** LIALB presented to ADEA, Council of Dental School Deans, Ft. Lauderdale, Florida.
- August 8, 2016** LIALB program introduced in Haiti through the Fieffe Foundation for Haiti, Inc.
- July 22, 2015** Crest & Oral-B delivers oral health resources to schools through dentalcare.com, including LIALB. Online K-12 Educators' Repository supports teacher lesson plans.
- October 21, 2014** Crest Oral-B offers oral health literacy training, and CE credit online, **Improving Oral Health Literacy: Teaching Primary School Students through the Lessons in a Lunch Box Program.** New sponsors include, Benco Dental, Patterson Dental and Shofu.
- October 15, 2013** LIALB featured, Dentistry Today, **Teachers Sink Teeth into Oral Health Education.**
- November 30, 2012** LIALB program reaches 15,000 elementary school children. Additional sponsors join the effort, including, adec, Ivoclar Vivadent, OrthoSynetics and Scion Dental.
- August 11, 2011** National Partnership for Action (NPA) through the United States Department of Health and Human Services becomes a supporter of the LIALB program.
- August 3, 2010** Program expands to 14 states, reaches 10,000 with more sponsors including ADAF, City of Baltimore, Delta Dental, DentalEZ Group, Doctor of Dentistry, NDAF, NDHA, Valley Dental Pediatric and Young Dental.
- March 29, 2009** LIALB presented to ADEA, Council of Dental School Deans in Dallas, Texas.
- January 12, 2008** First shipments of lunch boxes arrive in Maryland with additional support from ADHA, Brushtime Products, Colgate, Doral, Henry Schein and Sunstar Americas.
- August 20, 2007** \$25T grant award by the Dental Trade Alliance Foundation supports launch of LIALB.
- February 23, 2007** LIALB prototype and comprehensive program introduced to organized dentistry nationally, and endorsed by the AAWD, AGD, HIDA, NDA and the SAID.
- July 23, 2006** Lessons in a Lunch Box (LIALB) prototype and program introduced to the NDA.
